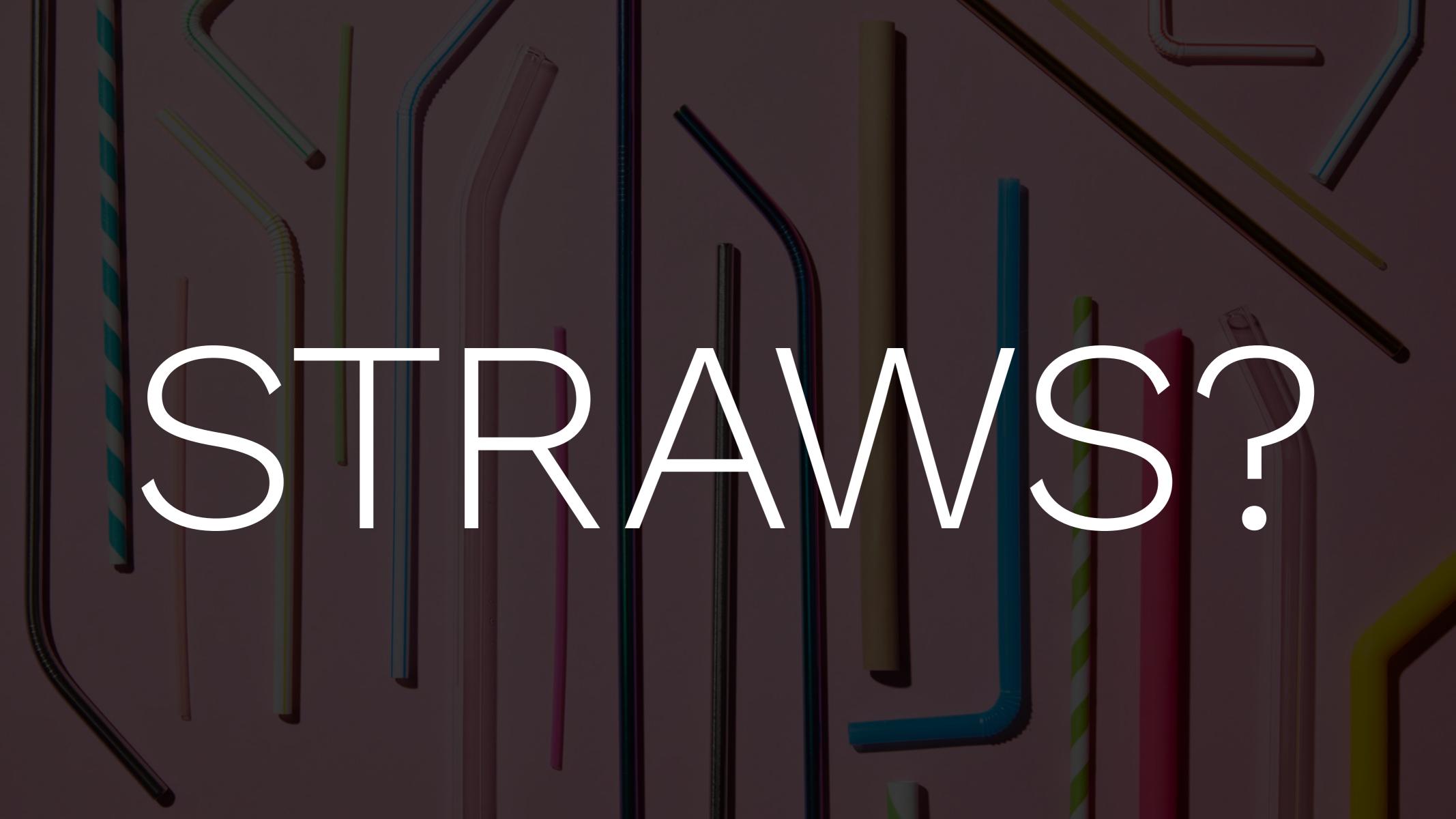

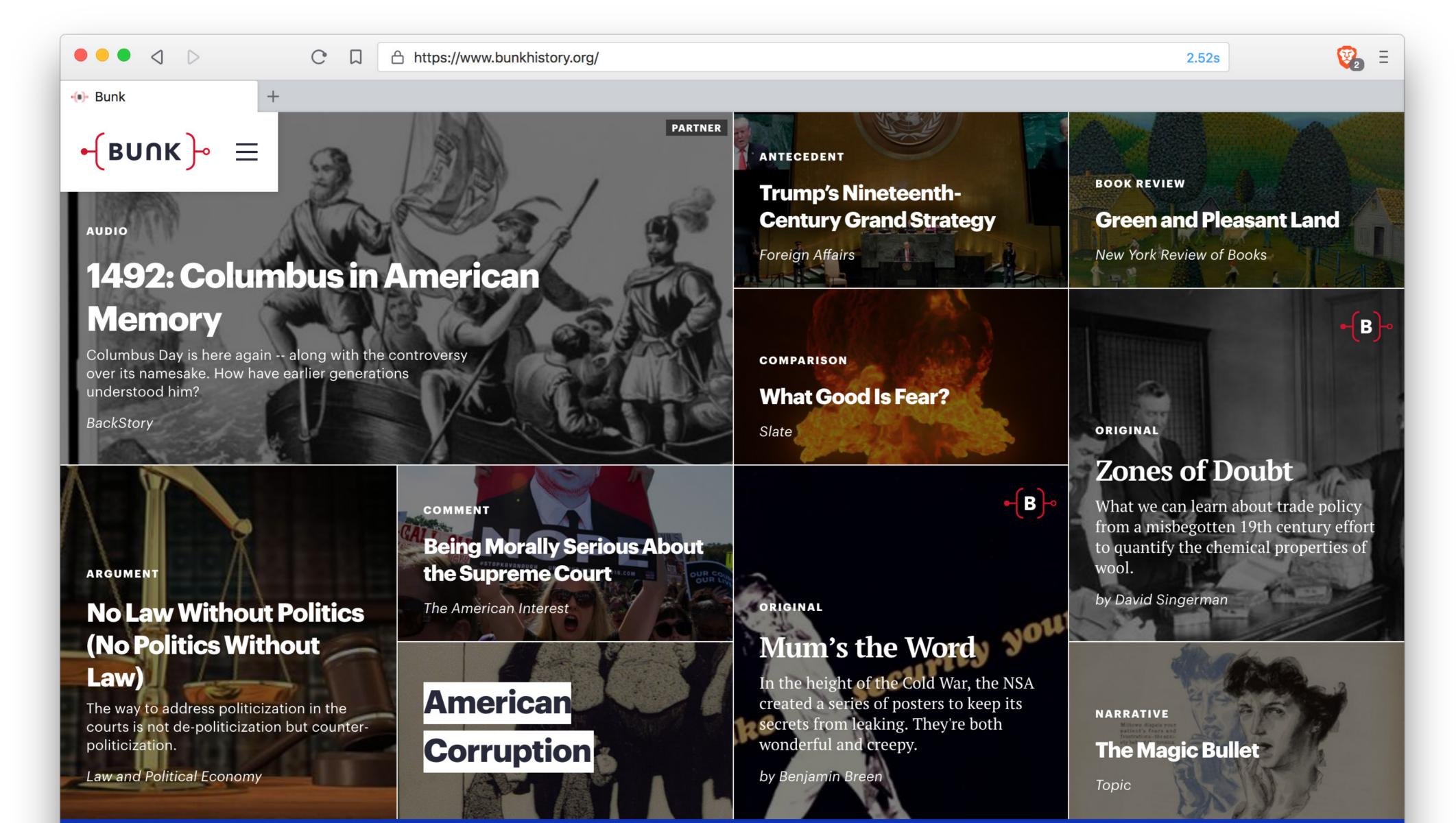

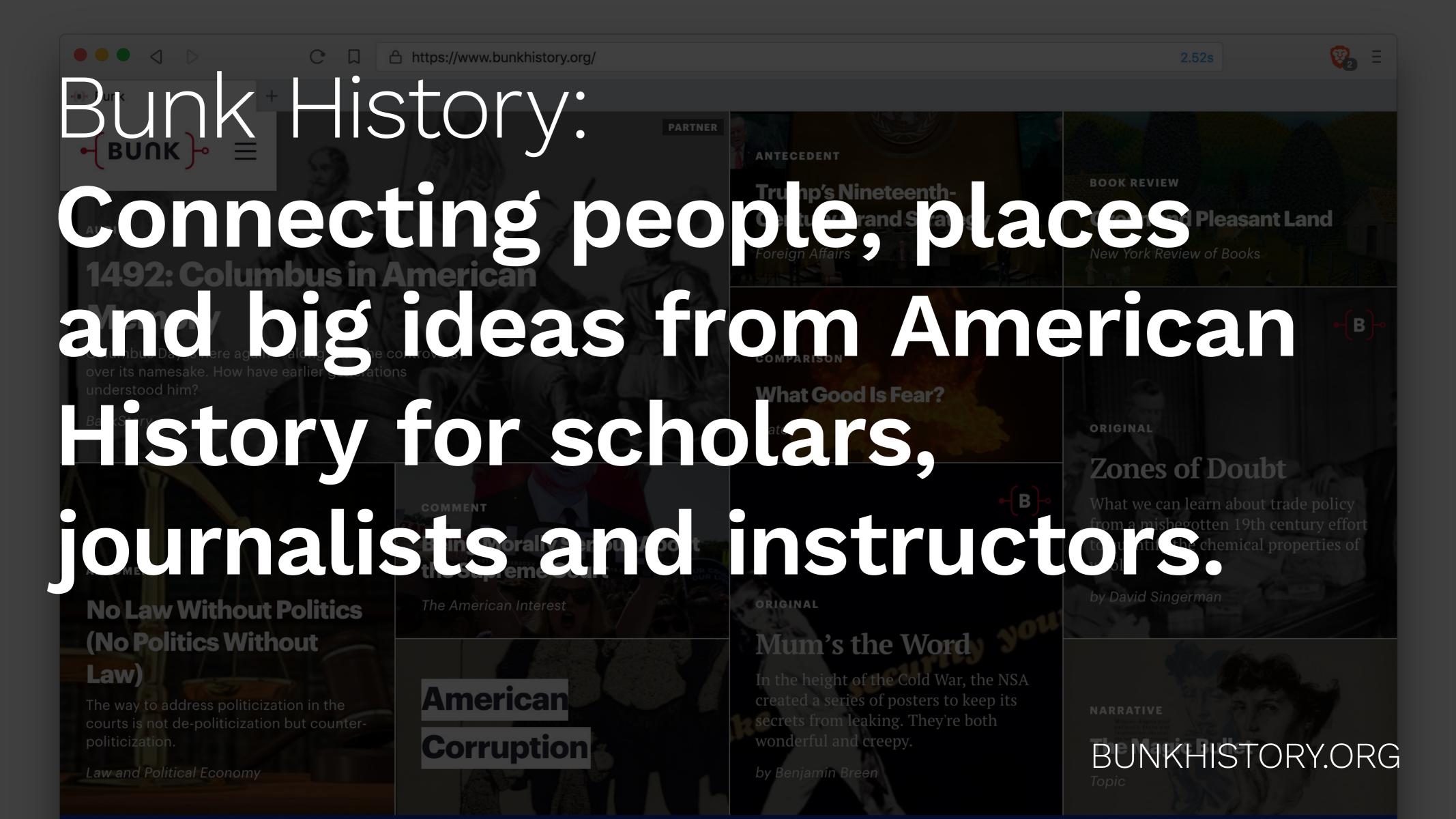

Actual Fact:

Suicide attempts among youth more than doubled from 2008 to 2015.

Almost 2/3 of those attempts involved girls.

The number of successful suicide attempts also more than doubled.

Suicide rates among girls ages 15–19 are at their highest level since we started tracking them.

Top causes: Social Media School Stress Loneliness Isolation

I believe this is a moral crisis.

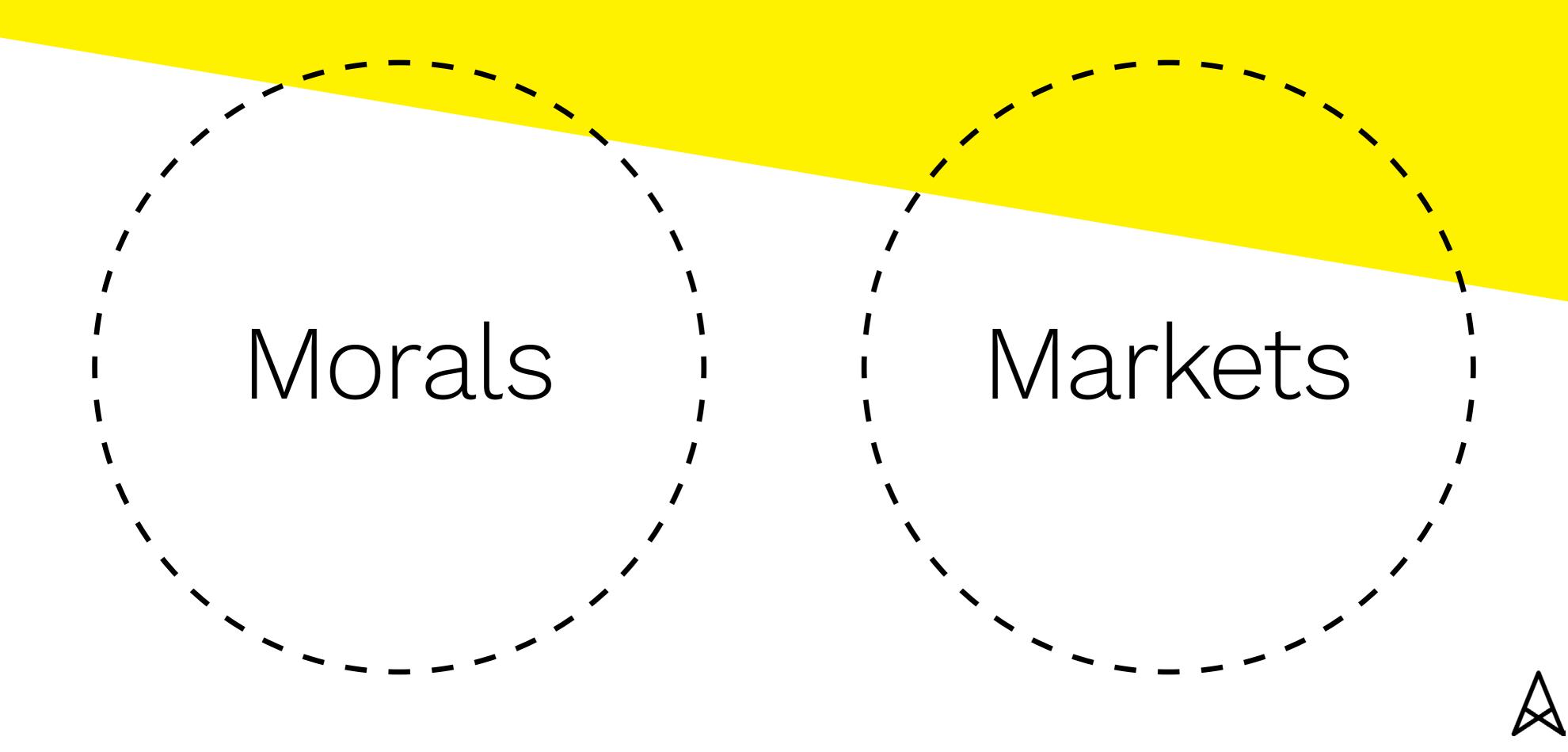


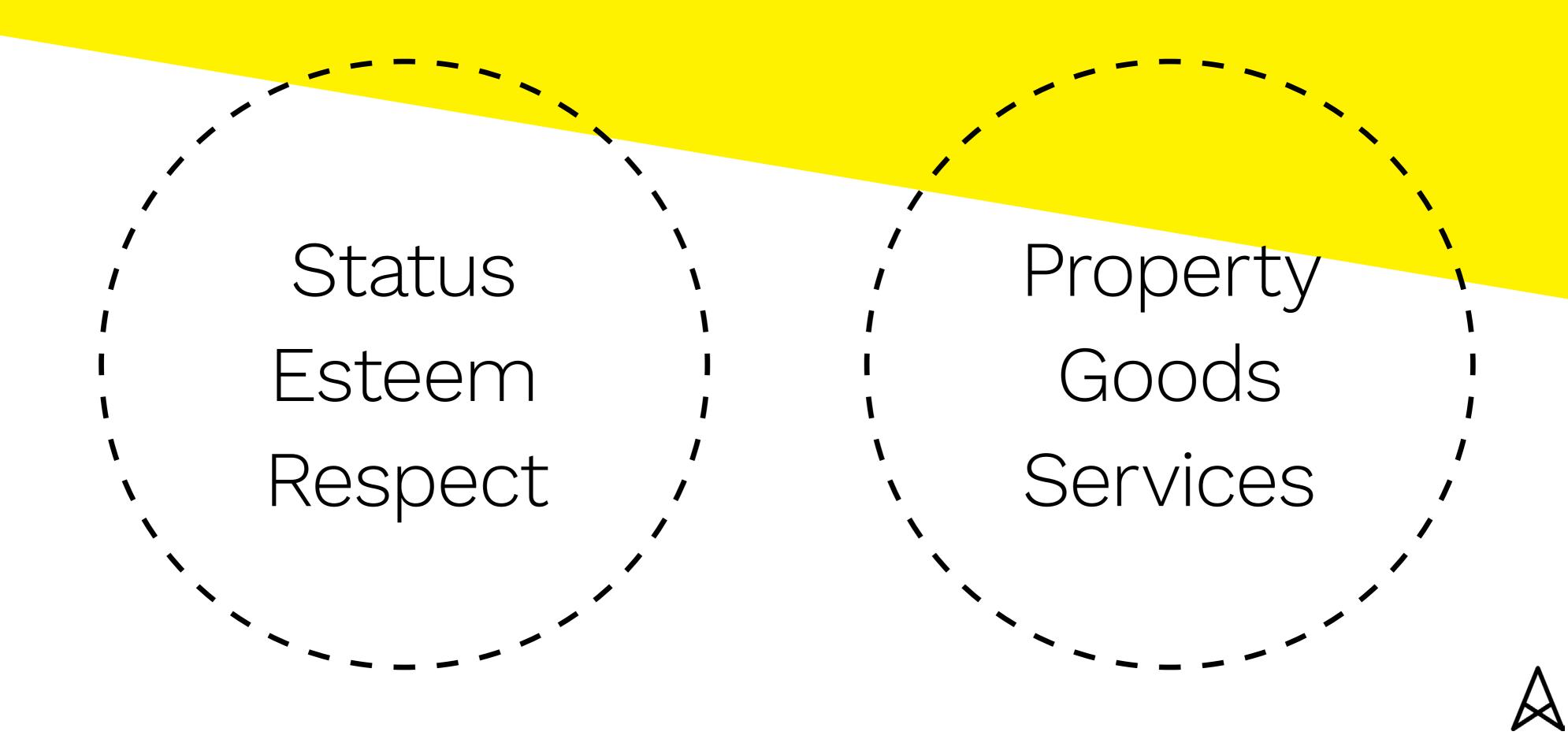
Because it involves a transfer of power, however slight, design is best understood as a moral pursuit.
