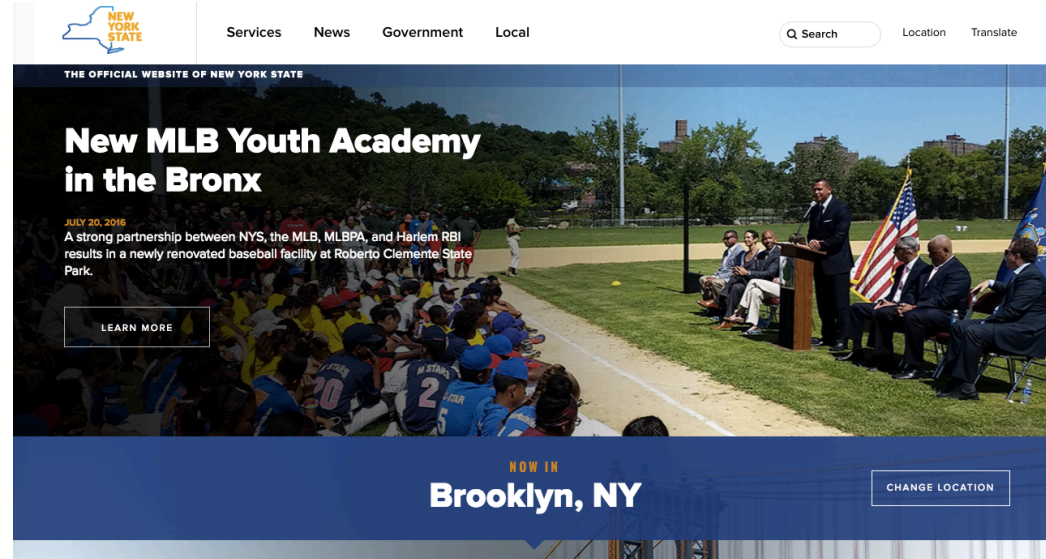

What Did WebNY Want to Do?

- Establish common processes, procedures and practices for the 60+ State agencies
- Support Governor Cuomo's Web Transformation Initiative
- Bring 200+ New York State websites to a common Acquia Drupal platform
- Enable WebNY team



WebNY Problem

- High cost of building and managing individual agency web sites
- Difficulties updating and governing sites
- Challenging to spin individual sites up quickly

WebNY Solution

- Acquia Cloud Site Factory
- Enablement of their leadership and development team by Acquia
- Enterprise best practices
- Agile!

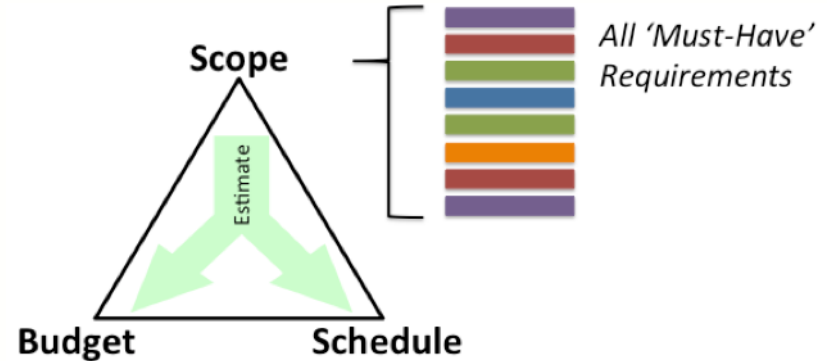

Reality Check

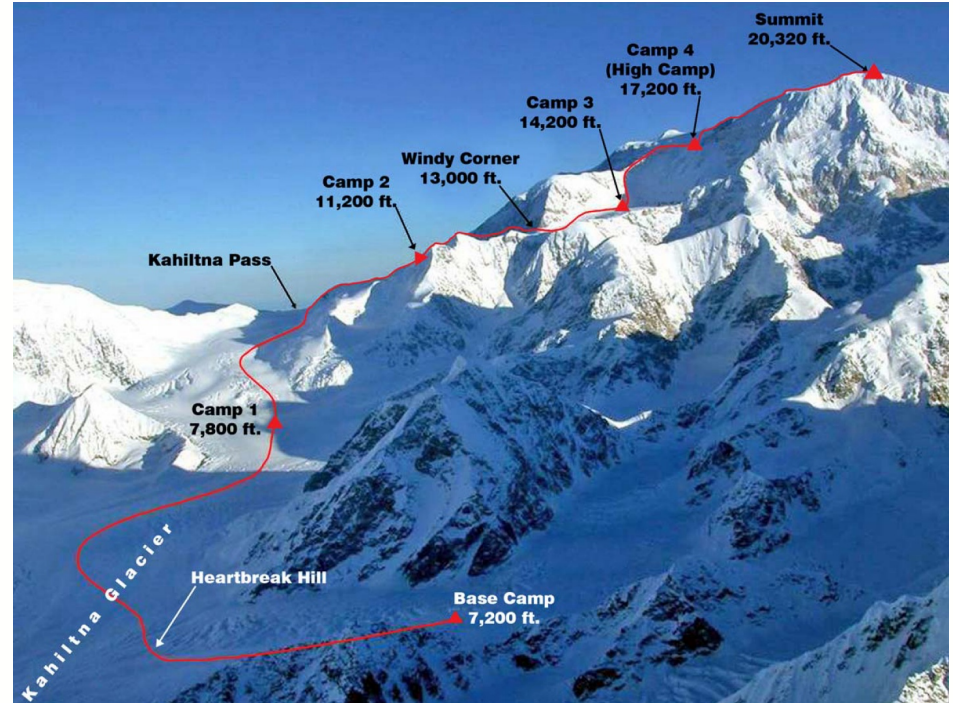
How 'bout that schedule?

- Had to consider inherent risk of D8
- Needed to enable team for D8
- We determined we could not deliver the full feature set given fixed resources



The Approach: MVP

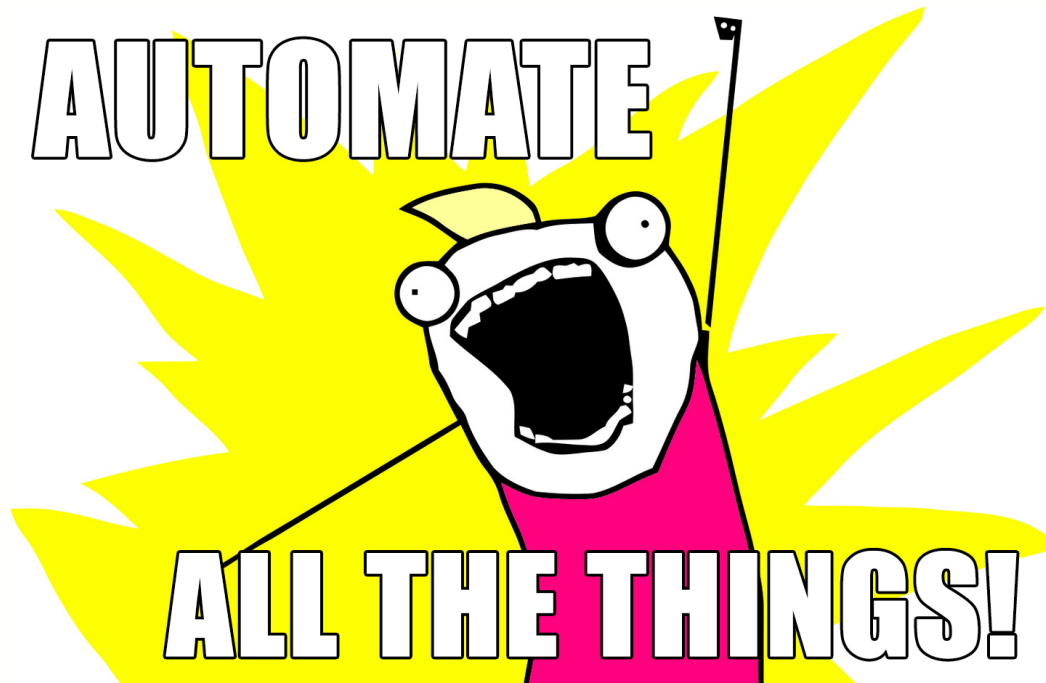
- What's an MVP?

- Frontend
- Platform
 - Automated Testing
 - Standards enforcement

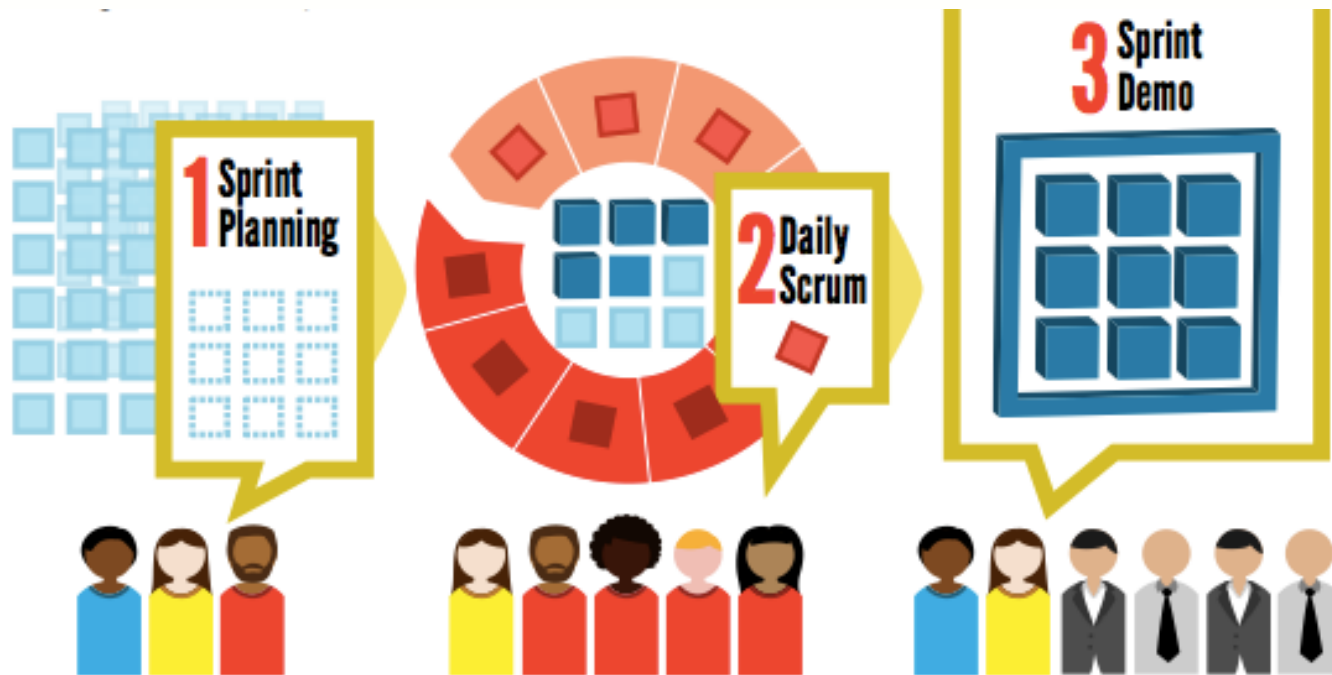


The WebNY MVP

- What did we eliminate and how did we arrive at the MVP architecture?
 - Automated content migration
 - No +1 features
 - Snowflake features
 - Custom module dev



Agile All The Way



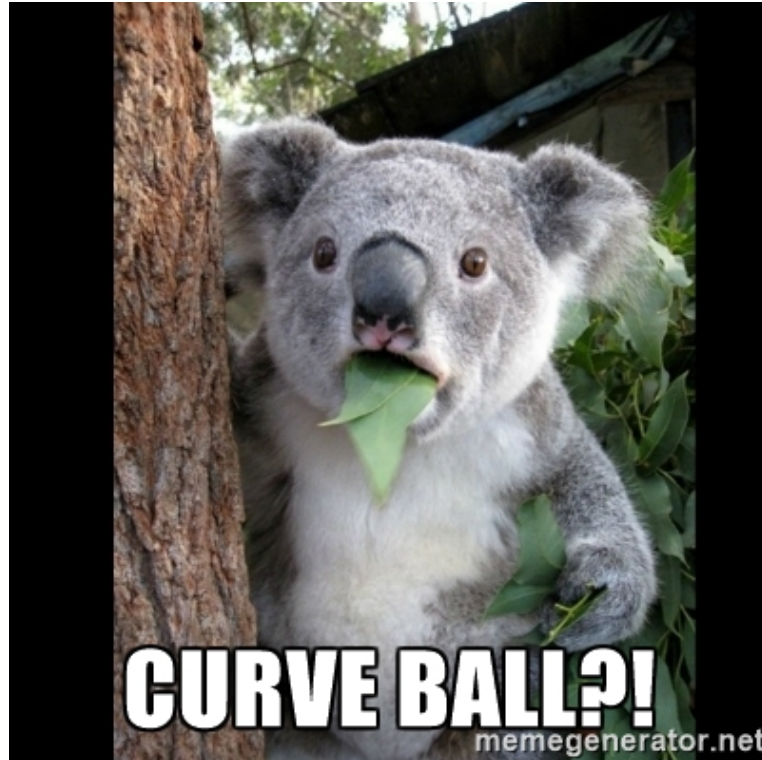
Making WebNY Successful

- Implement governance strategy from day 1
- Regular D8 readiness assessment
- Focused on Drupal core
- Limit custom code
- And finally...
